We are delighted that Ballakermeen will be welcoming back students in Years 7 to 10, and 12 on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

### **School Uniform**

We prefer school uniform to be the order of the day as we believe it creates a sense of belonging and avoids putting pressure on students to wear the latest designer labels. It is also worth noting that the need for clothes to be washed daily no longer applies. We understand that over the last few months some children may have outgrown some items that you have yet to replace. We will be understanding if you make us aware – a brief note will suffice. Blazers need not be worn. Official PE kit will be required.

# The Last Five Weeks of Term

The first two sessions of Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June will be spent in tutor groups. We will discuss any concerns students may have, pointing anyone who feels they might need additional support towards our Listening Service. Once regular lessons have commenced, the focus will very much be on learning. It is vitally important that we make the most of the short time we have remaining this academic year. We would appreciate your support in ensuring that your child arrives at school ready to learn, equipped with a pen, pencil, ruler, calculator and crayons. If student planners have been lost, we will issue new ones for the remainder of the school year. Please be aware that some of the previously scheduled events, such as Enrichment Week and work experience for Year 10, will not take place, although plans are underway for our House Sports Days.

The school will look similar to how it was before we went into lockdown. There have been a few tweaks, including additional hand washing stations and protective screens at our welcome desk and in one of the canteens. We will continue to encourage good hygiene and will remind students to wash their hands regularly. Hand sanitiser will also be available in classrooms.

We need to try and catch up on three missing months of education and as per usual, behaviour that affects the good order of the school will not be tolerated. Coughing in the faces of people and other Covid related misdemeanours, even if it is for 'a laugh', will be dealt with firmly. We will remind students of our expectations and their responsibilities as part of our community.

### **On-Line Provision**
