

## Dear Parent/Carer,

And so, we have arrived at the end of the school year, and what a year it has been! Parents, students, and staff have faced unprecedented challenges. I am greatly impressed with the imaginative and resourceful ways that our families managed home education, and enormously proud of my staff's dedication and hard work to keep our young people's learning going. We are very fortunate that management of the pandemic on the Isle of Man allowed a full return to school some five weeks ago. I am delighted to be able to tell you that our students have worked fantastically hard over this period and that we are in a good position for the start of the new school year in September.

I am keenly aware that many of our families have faced and are facing tough times. May I remind you of some of the support that is available from school. If your child is eligible for free school meals a new application must be made each year, and this will need to be done for September. There are also informal uniform 'swap groups' on Facebook and if anyone has any unwanted uniform or PE kit, we would be happy to collect items in and discreetly redistribute them. You may also have seen on Facebook that Miss Fleming has offered to repair blazers; all you need to do is put the blazer in a carrier bag with your child's name on it. Miss Fleming will be giving up the first week of her holiday, so it is not too late to make use of her kind gesture.

We know that the summer can feel awfully long for some students, so our Listening Service will continue throughout the break.
