Dear Parents and Carers

The online world can be a bit overwhelming at times, but it is important we understand what our children are doing online so we can help make them safer. The Safer Schools Isle of Man App aims to help with this. The app is available for use by young people and their parents/carers.

Safer Schools Isle of Man is designed to support and protect children by educating and empowering them both at school and at home. Through their log-in, your children get access to information that is relevant to them, and through your log-in you will receive tips and advice on how to keep them safer online. This includes alerts to security concerns and feature updates in commonly used applications and websites.





We are delighted to invite you to download the new **Safer Schools Isle of Man App** provided by our school insurance provider Zurich Municipal. **Please note that the new app is different to the one that was launched in 2019.**

Download and Log-in Instructions

1. Search '**Safer Schools Isle of Man**' and download the app.



2. When you open the app, you will be presented with a screen to choose your role. Select parent/carer or pupil. Parents/carers are required to create an account. This does not apply to pupils. If you are registering as a parent/carer, enter your details into the boxes provided and press '**register**', then agree to the terms and conditions.
3. Now you're logged in, you need to add your role. This corresponds to your role within the school community. You will be prompted to '**add school**'; use the appropriate QR code in the table below. If you opt to use a numeric code instead, search for Ballakermeen High School and then enter the appropriate 4-Digit number below. *The content for pupils is designed to be age appropriate, so please ensure they scan the QR code or use the access code relevant to their year group. There is a different code for parents/carers which is also included below.*
